KARE - Programs

<u>Food Pantry-</u> provides low-income families with well-balanced, nutritional food that supplement a minimum of 1 weeks' household grocery expenses.

Crisis Assistance

Provides clients that are experiencing short-term crisis situations, with assistance maintaining their most basic needs as well as counseling services. KARE is here to walk with our clients during their crisis and help them build the skills needed to maintain or regain financial independence.

KARE's community thrift store is open to the general public and provides all shoppers the opportunity to find great buys while saving money in their pockets and supporting a great cause.

- 11 homes repaired (3 projects completed by Youth Serve)

- 3,731 households received 635,073 lbs of food assistance
- 2,993 households received food assistance through partner agencies where KARE provided 36,596 lbs of food.
- 8,982 volunteer hours donated to KARE
- 375,092 lbs of food donated to KARE
